


Celebrating the 50th Anniversary Show for the Newfoundland Club of Victoria.

The club ran it's first championship show at the Melbourne Royal Showgrounds in 1975 with Mr E Drinkwater as the Judge, the first show attracted an entry of 63 dogs.

After this the club has successfully ran a show every year except for when COVID restrictions caused the cancellation of the 2020 and 2021 shows. 2022 saw the club back in action running a double header to catch the shows up for the 50th show to still match the 50th year.

While the committee has seen many members come and go over the years it is apparent the the commitment to keeping the breed club running and thriving to acknowledge and showcase the beautiful breed of Newfoundland dogs



A brief History by Meg Simpson (Life member now deceased.)

"Boy" (Wildfields Endeavour) was taken by Peggy Eustace; and Kingfishereach eventually came to Melbourne in 1968 and was given to Ian Wade, who at the time bred Bull Terriers. Ian tried in vain to obtain a mating with Majesty Kennels but they were not interested.

Mary and Don McCaul were at a show with their Westies and were asked by Ian to take "Rosie", that was her pet name. At first they said no way, but Ian kept on insisting and eventually they finally softened and took her, by this time she was 6 ½ years old. Mary and Don told Ian that if they ever did mate her he would get a puppy.

A short time later, Mary, while reading the paper saw that a lady by the name of Juliet Gibson was arriving that day from England, bringing with her two Newfoundlands. "Quick says Mary, let's go to the docks, we have found a husband for Rosie!" Those two dogs were "Wanitopa Gentle Giant" (35" at the shoulder and 240lbs) and "Eng Ch. Bonny Bay Jasmine". The dogs and Juliet were soon at Mary and Don's Springvale boarding kennels and Rosie was mated.

Rosie had eight puppies, Ian Wade got his puppy "Ch. Marydon Shannook", and I got my girl "Ch. Marydon Lady Giant". Sylvia and Ron Cameron got "Marydon Lady Dora".

Rosie had two litters from Giant and Jasmine had one litter.

That was in 1968. In 1969, we formed the Newfoundland Club Social and became affiliated as the Newfoundland Club of Victoria in 1974. It took that long because we had to have thirty dogs at the Melbourne Royal before we could be recognized, and as all the dogs came from Gentle Giant it proved to be very hard, but we got there.

As you will no doubt see that without Mary and Don McCaul, this club may well have never been started. Therefore, we, the Newfoundland Club of Victoria owe a great debt of gratitude to them both.

I was born into the dog world and somehow got stuck there.

Dogs have always been a huge part of my life. My choice of education, work, house, car and even the few vacations possible, have been deeply influenced by the dogs in my life.

Shortly after I was born, my parents bought their first Bernese Mountain dog and then it all began.

They started showing. After a short time they went to Switzerland for their second Bernese, year after the third and so it went on. They started breeding, founded the Bernese Mountain Dog Club in Denmark together with some friends and all the activities around our Bernese is what I mostly remember from my childhood. Of course, I went along to all the dogshows in Europe and also competed in the Child & dog competitions.

When I moved from home my first dog was a Bernese, but then I meet a charming Newfoundland bitch and fell totally in love with this breed. My Bernese died at 8 years from bone cancer and shortly after my first Newfie was born. She became the foundation bitch of my kennel Newetta's Newfoundlands. She gave me the first litter in September 1996 from a lovely American male and working with the Newfoundlands have been my biggest passion ever since.


I have been showing all over Europe and have won more than 100 champion, European and world Winner titles on Newfs I've breed or owned.

Beside this I've been president of The Newfoundland Club in Denmark and of a Regional club of The Danish Kennel Club. I teach in the Danish Kennel Club on a Basic course and I educate the showtrainers in the DKK. I'm a member of the health committee in the Danish Kennel Club and the DK representative in the FCI Breeding Commission.

I have been working nearly 18 years on the Danish Veterinary University and now I enjoy my work life on a small local Vet clinic.

Today I'm licensed to judge the Newfoundland, Leonberger, Landseer, the Bernese and Great Swiss Mountain Dog, the Appenzell and Entlebuch Cattle Dog and the danish national breeds Broholmer and Black Spitz.
